Level 2 Certificate in Driving Goods Vehicles (RQF)

This qualification is aimed at motorcycle/pedal cycle couriers, van drivers, rigid vehicle drivers and articulated or draw bar vehicle drivers. It is a combined knowledge and competence qualification which is aimed at individuals who would like to develop the skills and knowledge necessary to operate the above vehicles. This qualification forms the combined knowledge and competence component of the SASE Intermediate Apprenticeship in Driving Goods Vehicles (England). The qualification includes the following pathways with each pathway containing mandatory and optional content:

1. Motorcycle/pedal cycle courier pathway
2. Van driver pathway
3. Rigid vehicle driver pathway
4. Articulated or drawbar vehicle driver pathway

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

The total qualification time (TQT) for this qualification is 290 and of this 153 is recommended as the minimum guided learning hours (GLH).

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed through completion of a portfolio of evidence. Learners must demonstrate their understanding of how to deal with situations in a safe and professional manner.
